

CFA Program Services

- All persons under 21 years of age must have their parents or guardian hold a current membership in CF in order to receive services from CFA. All persons over 21 years of age must hold a current membership. A person must be born, diagnosed, or receive medical care within the boundaries of North Dakota to receive services from CFA.

Travel Benefits

CFA will reimburse 57.5 cents per mile (GSA) for travel to and from medical facilities for CF related care. If the distance is greater than 250 miles, one way, CFA will also reimburse for lodging at a rate of \$100 per night for a maximum of two nights.

- To apply for transportation funds, fill out the transportation worksheet and mail or hand deliver to the CFA office along with proof of CF related visit (visit itinerary, etc.)
- Family maximum reimbursement cap \$4,000 per calendar year.

Medication/Equipment Benefits

CFA will reimburse not more than 25% of the cost of any prescribed medication used by a CFA member who has CF. Therapeutic medical equipment (nebulizers, oxygen tubing, percussion vest etc.) are also covered under this policy. CFA will pay up to 50% of the cost of prescribed or doctor- recommended nutritional or vitamin supplements not covered by insurance.

- To apply for medication benefits, send a quarterly list from the pharmacy that lists:
 - Cost
 - Insurance payment
 - Date
 - Medication name
 - Balance due for the patient
- \$15,000 annual cap per member.

Scholarship Grants

CFA offers scholarship grants for CFA members seeking post-secondary education. The assistance advances payment for tuition, room, board, books and fees. Reimbursement is based on a number determined by averaging those costs for attending ND state schools. In order to qualify, you must:

- Have CF
- Be a CFA Member
- File a FAFSA
